Semen examination is commonly divided into: macroscopic (organoleptic), microscopic (using Blom table or microscope slide) and additional tests, such as e.g. sperm concentration or motility of spermatozoa).

The presentation will also provide a brief information about more modern, reliable and advanced method – computer-assisted sperm analysis.
