DESCRIPTION

This workshop introduces the cytological examination as a commonly used diagnostic method for FNA samples of various lesions, performed routinely in The Department of Veterinary Pathology, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

The focus will be on sampling, necessary equipment and reagents, techniques used to prepare cytological slides as well as the most common cytological diagnoses made in the Department of Veterinary Pathology.

The main goals of the workshop are:

- to bring cytological examination closer to students, veterinarians, and laboratory staff
- to present most common diagnoses made by cytological examination
- to exchange experiences and challenges in cytology between veterinarians and laboratory staff
