Such a method can help to teach student how to perform safety and properly clinical examination of synthetic cadaver first and only then on live animals. It can be useful to show them; vaginoscopy, rectal examination, place IV catheter, place the endotracheal tube on phantom and even how to solve the delivery and many other clinical procedures.
